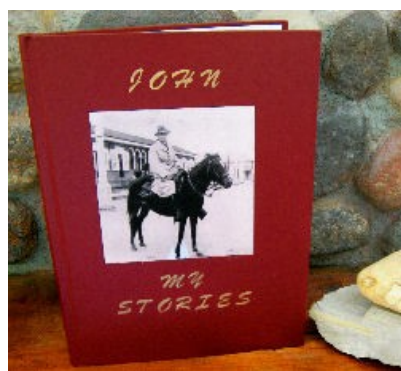

What is Guided Autobiography (GAB)?

Recognized throughout the world, Guided Autobiography has been researched and developed by Dr. James Birren over the past 30 years as a method for helping you document your life stories. Guided by a trained instructor, you will be led through themes and priming questions that evoke memories of events once known but filed away and seemingly forgotten. Each week, you'll write a two-page story on a life theme, bring your story to class and read it to a small group of receptive class members. Writing and sharing life stories with others is an ideal way to find new meaning in life and to put life events into perspective. You'll feel enlivened by the group experience, get to know your fellow classmates through their stories, learn more about yourself and gain a greater appreciation of life!
